FRENCH TOAST LOAF



INGREDIENTS

- 1 cup (1/2 pint) half-and-half
- 4 eggs
- 2 tablespoons sugar
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/8 teaspoon ground nutmeg
- 4 cups bread cubes (see Tips)

INSTRUCTIONS

- Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. Coat a 9- by 5- inch loaf pan with cooking spray.
- In a large bowl, combine all ingredients except bread cubes; mix well. Stir in bread cubes and allow to sit for 10 minutes, or until all the liquid has been absorbed.
- Spoon mixture into loaf pan and bake 55 to 60 minutes, or until golden. Remove loaf from pan, slice, and serve.
- Serve with maple syrup

At Home:

- Be extra cautious about locking windows and doors when you leave the house.

In The Neighborhood

- ✓ Be extra alert pay attention to who comes and goes.
- ✓ Volunteer to watch neighbor's homes if they go away and pick up their mail and newspapers.

Shopping

- Pay attention to your surroundings and the people around you. If you see people loitering in parking lots or garages, go the other way.
