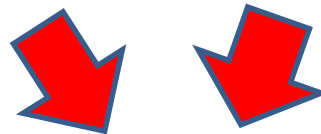

WHY IS THE “R” IN FEBRUARY SILENT?

Have you ever wondered why February has that silent first “r”?

Well, February, like the names of most months, has Latin roots. It descended from Februarius, a month in the ancient Roman calendar. The name actually comes from the festival of februum, a purification ritual celebrated during the month. I wonder if some thought it was derived in Boston, such as Cah (Car), Gahbidge (Garbage) Haavad (Harvad) Yahd (Yard). When playing wheel of fortune a Bostonian would never ask for the letter “R” it would just throw them off.



GROUNDHOG DAY, FEBRUARY 2ND, is the day the Groundhog – **Punxsutawney Phil** – comes out of his burrow on Gobbler’s Knob after a long winter sleep to look for his shadow. If he sees it, he regards it as an omen of six more weeks of bad weather and returns to his hole. If the day is cloudy and shadow-less, he takes it as a sign of spring and stays above ground.

BLACK HISTORY MONTH is an annual celebration of achievements by African Americans and a time for recognizing their central role in U.S. history. It was the brainchild of historian Carter G. Woodson and other prominent African Americans. Other countries around the world, including Canada and the United Kingdom, also devote a month to celebrating Black history.



The 2021 theme for Black History Month – “Black Family: Representation, Identity and Diversity” – explores the African diaspora, and the spread of Black families across the United States.
