



LOGGING INTO YOUR RENT MANAGER

Thank you for everyone who has signed up for, and uses Rent Manager to pay your rent. I thought it might be useful to put the log in steps in writing for you, as I know sometimes we forgot the steps from one month to the next:


Step 1: Log into your account. This is the link you must use. Always put it in the top address bar, not the middle search bar in google.




Step 2: Change to location to Lakes by clicking on the down arrow and selecting Lakes. Enter your username (your email address), and then your password:





Step 4: Once you have done this, you will get a confirmation that your payment has gone through. If you do not, see a confirmation, check your dashboard to see if there is a balance. If it does not say \$0.00, your rent payment has not gone through and you will have to repeat these steps.

THE HISTORY OF HALLOWEEN



Halloween is a holiday celebrated each year on October 31, and Halloween 2021 will occur on Sunday, October 31. The tradition originated with the ancient Celtic festival of Samhain, when people would light bonfires and wear costumes to ward off ghosts. In the eighth century, Pope Gregory III designated November 1 as a time to honor all saints. Soon, All Saints Day incorporated some of the traditions of Samhain. The evening before was known as All Hallows Eve, and later Halloween. Over time, Halloween evolved into a day of activities like trick-or-treating, carving jack-olanterns, festive gatherings, donning costumes and eating treats. Did you know that one quarter of all the candy sold annually in the U.S. is purchased for Halloween?!!

Borrowing from European traditions, Americans began to dress up in costumes and go house to house asking for food or money, a practice that eventually became today's "trick-or-treat" tradition. Young women believed that on Halloween they could divine the name or appearance of their future husband by doing tricks with yarn, apple parings or mirrors. Parents were encouraged by newspapers and community leaders to take anything "frightening" or "grotesque" out of Halloween celebrations. Because of these efforts, Halloween lost most of its superstitious and religious overtones by the beginning of the twentieth century. Between 1920 and 1950, the centuries-old practice of trick-or-treating was also revived. Trick-or-treating was a relatively inexpensive way for an entire community to share the Halloween celebration. In theory, families could also prevent tricks being played on them by providing the neighborhood children with small treats. Thus, a new American tradition was born, and it has continued to grow. Today, Americans spend an estimated \$6 billion annually on Halloween, making it the country's second largest commercial holiday after Christmas.

Halloween has always been a holiday filled with mystery, magic and superstition. It began as a Celtic end-of-summer festival during which people felt especially close to deceased relatives and friends. For these friendly spirits, they set places at the dinner table, left treats on doorsteps and along the side of the road and lit candles to help loved ones find their way back to the spirit world.

Today's Halloween ghosts are often depicted as more fearsome and malevolent, and our customs and superstitions are scarier too. So go ahead and enjoy Halloween 2021! The stores are already stocking up on bulk candy, so pick some up, watch a scary movie, or take in one of the many events available in the Tampa Bay area. We have listed some on the following page. Howl-O-Scream at Busch Gardens Tampa Bay

Weekends September 10 – October 31; \$41.99 / person and up. Busch Gardens Tampa Bay's annual Halloween production is back for 2021! Make your way through five haunted houses (three of which are new), eight uniquely themed scare zones, and hop on your favorite roller coasters after dark. This is a separate ticketed event that is not included with general park admission.



Sir Henry's Haunted Trail


