

Riverwalk is SO incrediably lucky to have a mailman like Dimitri taking care if our community day in and day out. Most of you don't realize how much he does extra for the residents. He is always in communication with me with any issues or packages. He KNOWS most of your names and what lots you live at just by hearing me say your first names. So please be kind – Here are a few helpful tips to make Dee's job alittle easier.

- Make sure you collect your mail on a weekly basis. Once you haven't picked up your mail for 4 weeks straight, your mailbox will be marked VACANT and your mail will be return to sender. How can Dee kept track of this you ask??? He measures this by the number of weekly flyers you have in your mailbox.
- Lost your key, please do not ask Dee to give you the mail in your box when he is at the boxes. Riverwalk does not have keys to your mailboxes. You will need to take your Riverwalk lot lease to the Gibsonton Post Office on US 41, pay \$35 to have your box rekeyed.
- Have you never received mail at Riverwalk? Same goes for you Submit your change of address form. Take your lease to the Gibsonton Post Office on US 41, Pay \$35 to have your mailbox registered and keyed. Then you can start receiving mail in the community.
- Receiving someone elses mail or previous tenants still? Mark the envelope "Return to sender" or "No Longer lives here" and push it all the way to the front of your mailbox so Dee can see it when he opens it from his side
- Do you have outgoing mail? We do not have an outgoing mailbox onsite, however if you would like to drop it at the office, I can place it with Dee for pickup.
- Make sure your box is locked at all times, if your mailbox no longer locks properly, you will need to go to the post office to get a new lock installed.
- Garbage cans at the mailboxes are for mail trash ONLY! Do not clean out your cars and dump the trash in these cans please.

2024 Riverwalk Village **POOL RULES & REGULATIONS** POOL HOURS 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. Maximum Load: 20

• Rules apply to all Residents and their Guests.

- All Bathers swim at their own risk.
- All guests and children must be accompanied by a resident host at least 21 years of age.
- Children 16 years or older may swim unsupervised. With one guest only
- If you have guests & the pool is at capacity and park residents want to use it, residents have first rights to it.
- A maximum of 3 guests are allowed at any one time.
- No Street clothes (Cotton or Denim) to be worn in pool, bathing suits only.
- Babies 2 years and younger must have swim diaper on while in pool.
- Parent of young children must supervise their child(ren) 's use of the restroom by either accompanying them or checking after use.
- All bathers must shower before entering the pool.
- No horseplay, such as dunking, shoving, front or back flips, running, jumping or cannonballs allowed.
- No alcoholic beverages, glass, Styrofoam, band aids, chewing gum, food, or animals in pool or on pool deck.
- Pool equipment and life preserver are not toys.
- No sports equipment in the pool.
- If you cut through lots to get to the pool you will not be allowed on that day. If you do it again you will not be allowed for 1 week.
- Do not leave trash behind.
- · NO SMOKING in pool area. Ashtray in pavilion building

Anyone not following the pool rules will be banned from the pool for a time to be determined by the management.

Carne Asada Recipe

Carne Asada prepared with a deliciously easy and authentic marinade just in time for your Cinco De Mayo menu planning! Juicy and tender grilled flank or skirt steak full of incredible Mexican flavours makes this homemade Carne Asada recipe better than any restaurant! Perfect for tacos, burritos, nachos...

Ingredients

- 1/4 cup fresh squeezed lime juice (about 3 limes)
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 4 cloves garlic, minced.
- 2 teaspoons ground cumin
- 1 teaspoon ground oregano
- 1 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1 1/2 teaspoons salt
- 1/2 teaspoon cracked black pepper.
- 1 pound (500g) skirt or flank steak*



Instructions

1. Whisk all the ingredients together in a large shallow bowl or plastic container. Add the meat, rotating to evenly coat, and cover with plastic wrap (or lid if using container).

- 2. Refrigerate for 2 hours or overnight.
- 3. Heat barbecue (or grill) on high heat. Note that lean flank steak is best cooked rare, while skirt steak can be cooked well without losing moisture or flavor because it has more fat marbling. Remove the flank steak from the marinade and discard excess marinade. Grill for 5-7 minutes per side, or until desired doneness is reached.
- 4. Transfer to a plate and allow to rest for 5-10 minutes.
- 5. To serve, slice against the grain into thin strips.

Cinco de Mayo, or May 5, is a holiday that celebrates the date of the Mexican army's May 5, 1862, victory over France at the Battle of Puebla during the Franco-Mexican War. The day, which falls on Sunday, May 5 in 2024, is also known as Battle of Puebla Day. While it is a relatively minor holiday in Mexico, in the United States, Cinco de Mayo has evolved into a commemoration of Mexican culture and heritage, particularly in areas

with large Mexican American populations
